



This class is designed for riders with permits who are currently riding and have conquered all the basics of riding. This class is also for those who have been riding for years and are finally ready to test for their license.

Already licensed or endorsed riders may also participate in this class, for skill practice purposes.

Note: Licensed motorcycle riders may bring their own bike if they choose. You will need to bring your license, insurance, and registration if you plan on using your own motorcycle. You may gladly use one of our training bikes as well.

Understand and agree that if you do not demonstrate minimum proficiency with basic motorcycle operation during the screening exercise at the beginning course, you will be dismissed from the course and counseled to enroll in a course better suited to your skill level. Please review the 7 requirements below to make sure you meet the basic criteria to take this class.

Verify you meet the following conditions for participation in the Basic RiderCourse2 at Schaeffer's, before enrolling in a class:

- 1. I am 18 years of age or over.
- 2. I am actively riding a motorcycle I own, including the abilities to:
  - Use the clutch and throttle to control a motorcycle, start out, and stop smoothly
  - Upshift and downshift smoothly
  - Stop a motorcycle properly at a designated point, and
  - Negotiate normal roadway turns and curves.
- 3. I understand and agree that if I do not demonstrate minimum proficiency with basic motorcycle operation during the screening exercise for the course, I will be dismissed from the course and counseled to enroll in a course better suited to my skill level.
- 4. I understand and agree that I will be dismissed from the course if I present a danger to my safety or the safety of others during any exercise or evaluation in the course.
- 5. I have no medical conditions or mental or physical limitations that would affect my learning or my safety or the learning or safety of others.
- 6. I have not used, and am not under the influence of alcohol, prescription or non-prescription drugs or any other substance that could impair my performance in this course.
- 7. I understand that completion of the Basic RiderCourse 2 does not guarantee I will be safe on the road. I am responsible for my own safety.

## 1. Complete 4 hr Online E-course prior to attending class

- There is a 4-hour E-course assignment (Epackage2) that must be complete before coming to class.
- E-course needs to be completed within the 30 day window before your class.
- Instructions will be sent via email & text (check spam file) once you are officially enrolled in a class & you are within the 30 day window of your class date.

\*If you are signing up another person in your family/group for a class, please make sure everyone has a different email address! Only ONE email address can be used per person for E-course purposes. Your email acts as your username, so please make sure you have a different email address entered per person enrolled.

# **E-COURSE (ONLINE CLASSROOM LEARNING)**


Licensing classes require students complete online training before coming to the first day of class. Training must be completed within the 30-days leading up to class. This is a required training, and part of your licensing class. The online learning has replaced in-person classroom learning and testing.

Online e-course logins for licensing classes are sent manually. Please be patient if the class date you enrolled for is already within the 30-day window (required timeframe for completing training). We will get your login information sent via email and text ASAP!

#### 3. After successful completion of the E-course & Range Skills Exam you will receive your Class M License!


• Note: This license will allow you to ride any type of motorcycle

### What your BRC Riding Journey Includes?

- 1. Instructors Certified by the Motorcycle Safety Foundation® (MSF) will instruct you.
- 2. Learn to ride on a Harley-Davidson® Street 500, QJ Moto SRV 300, KTM Duke 200 or 390 motorcycle. (We Provide the Bike!)
- 3. Learn basic skills like clutch & throttle control, shifting, turning, and braking and advanced skills such as cornering and hazard avoidance.









# **Required Riding Gear**

(FOR ALL CLASSES & TRAINING)

- $\begin{pmatrix} 1 \end{pmatrix}$  DOT approved 3/4 or full-face Helmet
- Eye protection (helmet visor, eyeglasses, sunglasses, goggles acceptable)
- Long-sleeve shirt or jacket (might want both depending on the weather)
- Long pants NO holes (denim or riding pants required)
- Over-the-ankle boots (sturdy, not canvas, low heel)
- 6 Full-finger gloves (motorcycle specific recommended)
